## *Pediatric* Emergency Assessment, Recognition and Stabilization

American Heart Association Certification Course

**Audience:** EMRs, EMTs, Nurses, and other healthcare personnel who assist with pediatric emergencies.

**Course Content:** PEARS teaches providers how to recognize respiratory distress, shock and cardiac arrest, and provide appropriate lifesaving interventions within the initial minutes of response until the child is transferred to an advanced life support provider. During the second part of class participants will learn to be a team member in an advanced life support resuscitation setting. There will be videos of sick children to help learn recognition and hands on practice of skills including participating in an advanced life support resuscitation.
